## GOOD REASONS TO VISIT

- Located at the heart of Paris's historic centre, just a stone's throw from Notre-Dame de Paris.
- The first palace of the kings of France and a major site of the French Revolution.
- An animated and dynamic tour using the Histopad, the tablet that takes you back in time.

**The place to come to admire the superb Gothic remains built under Philip the Fair and the oldest kitchens in Paris, dating back to the days of John the Good.**

The Kings of France abandoned the palace at the end of the 14<sup>th</sup> century to settle in the Louvre and in Vincennes. It then took on a judicial role, and part of the palace was converted into prison cells. The Conciergerie became one of the principal places of detention during the French Revolution, with the installation of the Revolutionary Court. Its most famous prisoner was Marie-Antoinette.

### ***DID YOU KNOW...?***

Prisons were installed here and their administration entrusted to a concierge, which is how the monument got its name: the "Conciergerie".
